

## **SOLID WASTE INFORMATION**

If you've had trouble with missed trash pickups in the past, make sure to visit the City of Houston's Solid Waste website (https://houstontx.gov/solidwaste) for information on their pickup schedule and rules. Here are a few important things to keep in mind:



- 1. Trash bins should be rolled out to the curb for pickup by 7:30 AM on Tuesdays, and every other week for recycle bins. Be sure to check the website for information on holiday schedules.
- 2. During recycle weeks, make sure to space out your bins at least 3 feet apart to make it easier for the pickup driver.
- 3. Curbside compostable yard waste bags and small shrub or tree bundles are picked up every week. If you've had trouble with missed pickups due to construction or blockages, you can call or use the City's app to report it.
- 4. Once your bins have been emptied, be sure to store them off the street and out of sight.
- 5. Large trash pickups happen on the third Thursday of each month, with even-numbered months for junk and tree waste and odd-numbered months for tree waste only. Make sure not to set out your items before the Sunday of that week.
- 6. If you're putting out large items for pickup, make sure they're not located under low tree limbs or electrical lines, as the crane driver won't be able to pick them up.
- 7. If you need an out-of-band curbside pickup, you can call Houston 311 or HTX Collect for a one-time service.

Don't forget about the City's free drop-off recycle centers and junk drop-off locations! Just bring a copy of your City of Houston water bill and an updated ID or zip code. To make sure you never miss a pickup day, download the City's mobile app (HTX Collect) and set reminders. And if you ever have questions or concerns, the City's Solid Waste website is a great resource for all the rules and regulations you need to know.

### MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

Ladies and Gentlemen of the University Oaks Community,

The seven members of your University Oaks Board of Directors hope that the year has gotten off to a fine start for you and your family. Here is a brief update about what we are doing.

#### **COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT:**

We continue to have a robust calendar of social engagements that are organized by the Socialistas, a group of dedicated residents who coordinate these gatherings. You owe it to yourself to drop by and meet your neighbors at some of these events. They are a lot of fun. Information about these events is broadcast in a monthly email blast from the board and in the newsletter.

#### **DEED RESTRICTIONS ENFORCEMENT:**

We continue to utilize Randall Management to monitor the neighborhood for deed restrictions violations. They review the neighborhood monthly and then send out letters to alert homeowners if their property is not in compliance with our restrictions in some way.

The Board is moving to seek the assistance of our attorney with regard to a small number of properties that are not in compliance with our restrictions following much deliberation and extensive efforts to obtain compliance in other ways.

#### **SECURITY:**

We have revamped our security so that it will cost us less and also be more effective. Our previous security arrangements were provided by two professional and courteous off-duty police officers but they were costing us more than we could afford and provided a limited offering of hours when patrols could be conducted.

You will start seeing cars from Grey Services, a private security firm, patrolling in marked cars.

The company and its owner have been vetted by the board in a process that included reviewing their contract, references, staff, policies, and insurance.

#### **BUDGETING AND 2023 DUES:**

Our 2023 budget is being finalized now that security expenses have been ironed out. We will make every effort to operate within our means and be good stewards of your dues.

2023 dues are now due and payable and the statements have been mailed out to you. The dues for this year are \$220.00.

#### **BOARD MEETINGS AND YOUR INPUT:**

Our board meetings are the second Wednesday of each month from 7:30-8:30 via zoom. Please attend and offer us your comments and feedback about issues in University Oaks. We work for you ultimately and we would appreciate hearing your comments and suggestions. If you can't make the meetings then don't hesitate to email us at the addresses that you can find on our website.
